- Busy Year with a Full Plate
- Initial Major Goals
 - Review all Governance documents for DEI emphasis
 - Explore MSIs both for approval and making awards
 - Develop list of barriers to Membership, especially focusing on those under represented.
 - Establish ARCS Scholar/Alum virtual network
 - Develop an ARCS Scholar Acceptance form to be used by partner universities with demographic scholar data





- Initial Major Goals (cont'd)
 - Find and organize Resource material, especially on ARCS Scholar activities
 - K-12 Scholar Mentoring, establish criteria, find funding, work to pilot
 - Work with other committees to coordinate efforts





- What did we accomplish?
 - Worked with Governance Committee to incorporate and standardize DEI language in governance documents
 - Developed a Membership Conversation Tool, which has been piloted and presented at this meeting.
 - Piloted ARCS ACCESS, which currently has about 100 participants representing four Chapters: Northern California, San Diego, Illinois and Minnesota.



- What did we accomplish? (cont'd)
 - Model for ARCS Scholar Mentoring has been established, to be piloted by Pittsburgh Chapter during 2023-24
 - Worked with Communications and Marketing for two DEI oriented newsletter articles





- What still needs to be done?
 - Develop a program to include MSIs and/or their students in ARCS Foundation
 - Develop a Model Acceptance Form in conjunction with University Relations
 - Work with Information Strategies and Communications and Marketing to develop Resource media and content
 - More communicating and working with other
 Committees and the Chapters
